

India bans LTTE for another five years

New Delhi, May 14 (GNS) : The Indian government has extended for another five years its ban on the Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam (LTTE), which assassinated former Indian Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi in 1991, it was announced on Tuesday.

The step was taken under sub-sections (1) and (3) of section 3 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 (37 of 1967) with immediate effect, an official notification said.

"The LTTE's continued violent and disruptive activities are prejudicial to the integrity and sovereignty of India; and it continues to adopt a strong anti-India posture as also continues to pose a grave threat to the security of Indian nationals," the announcement said.

The LTTE, which was described as a militant and political organisation, has been blamed for the May 1991 suicide bombing at an election rally near Chennai which killed Rajiv Gandhi and several others, prompting one of the biggest crackdowns in India.

New Delhi first outlawed the LTTE in 1992 and has periodically extended the ban.

The Tigers were also blamed for many high-profile assassinations including that of Sri Lanka President Ranasinghe Premadasa and Defence Minister Ranjan Wijeratne in Colombo as well as leaders of the rival EPRLF group in the heart of Chennai.

At one time, the LTTE controlled one third of Sri Lanka's land territory and two-thirds of the island nation's coastline before it was crushed by the military in May 2009 in a gruesome war that claimed thousands of lives.

LTTE supporters based outside Sri Lanka continue to spew hatred against India, blaming New Delhi for the group's military destruction.

Inform about beggar; get Rs 1,000 award!!

Hyderabad, May 14 : The Director General of Prisons and Correctional Services, V K Singh, has stated that if any beggar is found in any location of Hyderabad city, people can inform to their control room Phone numbers 040-24511791, 24527846 and their Anandashram, Chanchalguda Phone Number 040-24414940 to help eradicate begging in the city.

In a press note today, he said that Telangana Prisons Department has announced a reward of Rs.1000 to anyone who reports a beggar to the officials. This step is taken to involve the public in this project and create public awareness.

He said the Depart-

ment has taken up the responsibility of beggars. The department has two structures at Central Prison, Chanchalguda and Central Prison, Cherlapally for rehabilitation of male and female beggars respectively—Anand Ashram, Chanchalguda (for males) and Anand Ashram, Cherlapally (for females). So far, they have picked up 8438 male beggars and 4977 female beggars.

"Our proposals to extend the facilities of Anand Ashram has been pending with the Government. Once we get approval, we will start Anand Ashrams in all the Districts of Telangana", he added.

Desperation showing on Modi's face: Owaisi

Hyderabad, May 14 : Predicting the defeat of the BJP in the ongoing Lok Sabha elections, AIMIM chief Asaduddin Owaisi on Tuesday said desperation was showing on the faces of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and other BJP leaders. Owaisi told reporters that the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) will not be able to form the government again as it will suffer defeat everywhere. "Desperation is there to be seen on faces of the Prime Minister and other BJP leaders. The results will not be on their expected lines. They wrongly assumed that losses in UP would be compensated in West Bengal and Odisha which is not going to happen. Everywhere in India they are going to lose seats," he said.

The All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM) leader said the regional parties will play a key role in the formation of the next government at the Centre.

Owaisi, whose party is an ally of Telangana Rashtra Samithi (TRS), said TRS President and Telangana Chief Minister K. Chandrababhan Rao was moving in the right direction to form the Federal Front.

Owaisi said KCR needed to be congratulated for his political sagacity and vision.

"Till yesterday nobody knew Federal Front. Today they are recognizing it as an alternative. This will be good for country," he said referring to KCR's meetings with Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan and DMK leader M.K. Stalin.

Owaisi claimed that the TRS chief was giving a reply to those who were questioning his secular credentials. "Wait till May 23. I can't answer hypothetical questions," said Owaisi when asked if he would extend support to a Congress-led coalition if the KCR does the same.

On the incidents of rape of women in Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh, Owaisi accused Modi to expose for his hypocrisy and duplicity. He wondered why Modi was silent on the rape in Hapur in Uttar Pradesh. "The Prime Minister is so arrogant that he does not want to do some introspection when it comes to him.

Emergence of third front will be known after elections: Stalin

Chennai, May 14 (GNS) : DMK President M.K. Stalin on Tuesday said only after the Lok Sabha election results are declared it will be possible to know if a non-Congress, non-BJP grouping is possible to govern the country.

He reiterated that Telangana Chief Minister K. Chandrababhan Rao met him on Monday as a mark of courtesy.

Speaking to reporters here, Stalin said he does not know whether a third front would be formed.

This will be known only after the election results are declared on May 23.

He said Rao came to Tamil Nadu to visit temples and also wanted to meet him (Stalin).

Stalin said Rao did not meet him in connection with forming a third front.

Rao on Monday had an hour-long meeting with Stalin here but it appeared that his proposal for a non-BJP, non-Congress coalition didn't have takers.

Student protests continue in Kashmir Valley against rape

Srinagar, May 14 (GNS) : Students at many places in the Kashmir Valley took to the streets and clashed with security forces on Tuesday in protest against the rape of a minor in Jammu and Kashmir's Bandipora district.

Students of Amar Singh College came out of the campus and fought pitched battles with the security forces here. The students were demanding a speedy trial of the accused, who has been arrested, and justice for the

victim. Students also protested in large numbers against the heinous crime in the Kashmir University campus in Srinagar.

The students carried banners demanding death for the accused. They appealed that nobody should use the highly sensitive issue for vote bank politics and everyone must try and get speedy justice to the victim. Student protests were also held at a number of other places but these ended peacefully. Protesters demanding

exemplary punishment to the rapist again blocked the Srinagar-Baramulla highway.

At some places, the moving vehicles were stoned, forcing the traffic to stop. Police have arrested the accused, Tahir Ahmed Mir, and set up a special investigation team (SIT) to complete the investigation speedily.

The crime was committed on May 9 when Muslims in the Valley were busy breaking their daily fast during the ongoing holy month of

Ramadan. Police have also booked the principal of a private school that had issued a date of birth certificate in favour of the accused showing him as a minor. Preliminary medical examination of the accused shows Mir is an adult. There has been widespread condemnation of the crime with all religious, political and social organisations appealing to people to maintain sectarian brotherhood so that the police are able to take the investigation to its logical end.

After wife says he won't campaign, Sidhu shares stage with Priyanka

Amritsar/Bathinda, May 14 (GNS) : Hours after his wife claimed that he won't campaign for the Congress in Punjab, Cabinet Minister Navjot Singh Sidhu shared the stage with Chief Minister Amarinder Singh and Congress General Secretary Priyanka Gandhi on Tuesday threatening a "knockout punch" to the Badals. Congress star campaigner Sidhu will not campaign for his party in his home state as the Chief Minister has told him not to, his wife and former MLA Navjot Kaur said. Sidhu later clarified at an election rally in Bathinda amidst the presence of Priyanka Gandhi and Amarinder Singh that he was returning to Punjab on May 17 to deliver a "knockout punch" to the Badals.

Amidst reports that the Minister's health was not allowing him to campaign, his wife also blamed the party's Punjab in-charge Asha Kumari for not allowing Sidhu to campaign in Punjab.

"Captain Saab is our smaller captain and Rahul Gandhi is our bigger captain and he has given duty to him (Sidhu) in other states and Navjot is busy campaigning there," she told reporters in

Amritsar city. "When Captain Saab and Asha Kumari have taken the lead role in ensuring victory of the party in all (13) seats, then what is the need for Navjot (Sidhu) to campaign in Punjab?"

The cricketer-turned-politician on Tuesday headed to Bihar to address a rally for Shatrughan Sinha, the party's Patna Sahib candidate. Navjot Kaur, a former BJP legislator from Amritsar (East), also blamed the Chief Minister for denying her a Lok Sabha ticket either from Chandigarh or Amritsar.

Crowd-puller Sidhu was conspicuously absent from Rahul Gandhi's two election rallies in Punjab on Monday.

On Tuesday he made a brief speech at the Priyanka Gandhi rally in Bathinda: "Here comes Sidhu on May 17, 'bhag' (run) Badal bhag". He said he would hold 10 rallies on May 17 if Congress candidate Amarinder Singh Raja Warring asked him to do so. Legislator Warring is pitted against Shriomani Akali Dal's outgoing MP and Union Minister Harsimrat Kaur Badal, daughter-in-law of former Chief Minister Parkash Singh Badal.

Many hate me because I speak the truth: Aiyar

New Delhi, May 14 (GNS) : Congress leader Mani Shankar Aiyar, who on Monday said he stands by his 'neech aadm' jibe against Prime Minister Narendra Modi and termed it "prophetic", on Tuesday said that anything he says is always misused as many people hate him for speaking the truth. "Anything I say is always misused because there are people who hate me. And they hate me because I tell the truth. And I will go on telling the truth," he told reporters here.

Asked about his comment on Modi, Aiyar said: "There is an entire article and then you pick one line and say please tell about that one line. I am not going to play into your

hands. Main uloo hoon, par itna bhi uloo nahin hoon (I am an idiot but not a big idiot)."

"I have given the article to two people, Rising Kashmir and to The Print. It is your job to inform people what I want to say, it is not my job."

The Congress leader on Monday in an article titled "Modi's ouster on May 23 will be India's fitting reply to the most four-mouthed PM." Contacted over telephone, Aiyar told: "I have nothing to add to my article."

In his article, Aiyar said that Modi needs to be warned that he is guilty of anti-national activity in trying to ride on the sacrifices of the Army and CRPF martyrs; of defam-

ing the Indian Air Force by portraying them as "complaisant idiots" in his "scientific illiteracy"; and the Indian Navy as being packed at its highest echelons with traitors who would acquiesce in unauthorized foreigners being allowed to board a top of the line defence vessel.

The Congress President also accused the Modi government of doing injustice to the people and said Congress' NYAY scheme will cure this injustice. "Five crore families will be benefited under the scheme. Demonetization and GST have destroyed the economy, NYAY will improve it. "Thousands of industries were shut due to demonetization and the GST, unemployment also rose. But as soon as people will get the money under the scheme, economy will improve."
