**CIRCULAR**

***Sub: Students Group Medi-claim policy for Hyderabad main campus for the academic year 2018-19 - Regarding.***

The University has been extending Students' Group Medical Claim through Insurance Companies for those students who have enrolled at MANUU Gachibowli Main Campus, Hyderabad every year on self-financing mode after collecting on annual basis. Last academic year 2017-18, the University had collected Rs. 950/- as annual premium. For the current academic year 2018-19, the University has collected Rs.1200/- per student provisionally for the group medi-claim benefits.

2. However, due to increased number of self-referral cases by the students, the quantum of claims became doubled the total premium paid by the University towards the Group Med-claim policy. This has resulted in a situation where none of the Government or Private Insurance Companies coming forward to provide Group Medi-claim policy for the MANUU Students mainly on the grounds of excess claims during the last 2 years. The University officials have been holding continuous discussions and meetings with several Government Insurance Companies like National Insurance Company, New India Assurance Company, Oriental Insurance Company etc. in the past but they are not coming forward to offer insurance cover so far even at higher rates.

3. The University is now exploring the possibility of roping in the TPA which is providing group medi-claim benefits to the students of University of Hyderabad but nothing is materialised so far. In case, the University is unable to find a suitable insurance company for medical coverage of students within a fortnight, the same will be notified and the amount collected for the above purpose shall be refunded.

4. Meanwhile, all the students enrolled at MANUU Main Campus, Hyderabad are advised to strictly avail basic medical benefits from the University Health Centre only and in case of emergency cases, the University Medical Officers shall refer the students to Government Hospitals. Till finalization of a Group Med-claim Policy, the University will not be responsible for any medical claims by any students.
