Guidelines for Polling Officers

- 1. Polling Officers (POs) are requested to report at the polling station one hour before the commencement of elections.
- 2. Three POs shall be stationed at the two Entrances to monitor entry points.
- 3. POs may collect polling material kit from the Returning Officers (ROs) half-an-hour before the commencement of polling.
- 4. At the polling booth, verify that the kit contains all the material listed on the checklist provided.
- 5. The RO team will visit each booth before polling begins.
- 6. Each booth will be assigned three polling officers and they may divide their duties as suggested:
 - a. P.O. 1 Verify ID Card and take signature of voters
 - b. P.O. 2 Issue ballot paper and sign on ballot paper
 - c. P.O. 3 Ensure that all ballot papers are dropped in the polling box
- 7. Voters are not allowed to bring their mobile phones inside the polling station.
- 8. Ensure University ID is produced for identification, and in case of non-availability of the same, a valid photo identity proof like Aadhar card, Driving Licence etc. can be produced along with fee-paid receipt of the current semester which will prove that they are enrolled at the university. A photocopy of the fee-paid receipt has to be submitted by the voter/s to the POs.
- 9. Hourly data of number of votes cast will be collected; POs are requested to supply the required information.
- 10. Separate tallies may also be noted on counting sheets to record the number of voters.
- 11. POs are instructed to record any untoward incidents and report such incidents to the Observers. Ensure that each voter casts their vote only once.
- 12. Collect voting material from voters such as marker pens which are used on the ballot paper.
- 13. At the close of polling:
 - a. CRO (Chief Returning Officer) and team will visit every booth and seal the ballot boxes
 - b. All the material given in the kit may be handed over as per the checklist
- 14. Place the ballot boxes in the secure space earmarked by the CRO.
