Kindly note that:

- The venue for the lecture is indoor stadium
- Live streaming of lecture on LED wall screens will be available at DDE auditorium and Center for Urdu Culture Studies (CUCS).
- Since the capacity of the indoor stadium has limitation, students and staff will be allowed on first come basis only to the extent of available capacity and others may avail facilities at DDE and CUCS.
- Entry into Indoor stadium is permitted to persons with an invitation card and valid id card only
- Eatables and water bottles are not permitted into the indoor premises.
- Mobiles must be kept on silent mode inside the indoor stadium
- Entry into indoor stadium will be stopped by security agencies half an hour before the start of the program and if the capacity is full
