Election candidates must declare offshore assets now

Kolkata, March 1 (GNS): Candidates in the upcoming Lok Sabha elections will have to declare their offshore moveable assets and liabilities in their affidavit, as per an amendment made by the Election Commission of India (ECI), an official said on Friday.

"To ensure that all moveable assets are reflected in the affidavit given by the candidates, a further category 'offshore assets' has been included for details of deposits of all assets and liabilities in foreign countries," Additional Chief Electoral Officer, West Bengal, Sanjay Basu told reporters.

He said Form 26 has been amended to ask candidates to submit a

statement of their income tax (I-T) returns for the last five years while they earlier had to file a statement of their (I-T) returns for just one year.

Alongside details of spouse and three dependents in the family, a new row has been inserted bearing the title Hindu Undivided Family for PAN details and status of I-T filing.

The office of the Chief Electoral Officer of the state will convene a meeting with all political parties regarding the changes, he said.

The VVPAT will allow the voter to see whether the paper trail displays the same choice that he/she had pressed in the EVM.

Another major change is that both candidates and political parties can spend up to Rs 10,000 in cash. Any expenditure above this has to be made in electronic mode like RTGS or by cheque, draft, etc, he said.

"As far as donation is concerned, candidates cannot take more than Rs 10,000 in cash. Even in this case, anything above this amount has to be in electronic form," he said.

The ECI has launched a new GIS-enabled mobile application called 'cVIGIL', which creates a fast-track complaint reception and redressal system.

"Using this app any citizen can either take a photograph or make a two minute video if they see any violation of the Model Code of Conduct (MCC) or expenditure and upload it," he said.

Aftab said no content must be uploaded from phone memory, only live photo or video can be shared. A person can do it anonymously or share personal details and he/she will be updated about the status within 100 minutes, he added.

Police arrest LeT militant involved in weapon snatching

Srinagar, March 1 (GNS): The police on Friday arrested a Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) militant who was involved in weapon snatching incidents.

"Based on a specific input regarding the movement of a suspected person near the Bone and Joint Hospital here, a special team of Srinagar Police apprehended a person.

"On questioning, he identified himself as Showket Ahmed Khan, a resident of Budgam district associated with the LeT, the banned terrorist organisation. His code name is Aumer Bhai," the police said.

"The arrested person was involved in weapon snatching incidents. Further questioning is going on," the police said.

Although the police are yet to confirm it officially, sources said the arrested person was a constable who worked with the state armed police before going underground. "He is believed to be involved in the weapon loot that took place on December 31, 2018 when four rifles went missing from the guard's room of a Congress legislator in Jawahar Nagar area of Srinagar," sources said.

Goa Minister defends use of 'bouncers' at official meeting

Panaji, March 1 (GNS): A Goa Minister on Friday defended using "bouncers" at a state government meeting instead of police, saying they were "healthy Goans", who just happened to be wearing jeans and black shirts. Responding to a series of questions from mediapersons at the state Secretariat about hiring bouncers instead of using the police, Town and Country Planning Minister Vijai Sardesai said if he rolled up his sleeves and flexed his muscles, he would also look like a bouncer. "The problem is this. If you have jaundice, you will see the world with a yellow tint...so, it is how you look at it. Now if you see a good, healthy Goan and you think he is a bouncer, it's your problem. We are a young political party and in this young party, there are many youngsters who work out," Sardesai said.

Photos of the bouncers guarding the office of the South Goa Planning and Development Authority (SGPDA) during a meeting on Thursday went viral in social media resulting in widespread criticism. Sardesai also said that using the "bouncer" slur was unfair and there was no question of intimidating anyone. "What's a bouncer? Don't I look like a bouncer? Should I roll up (his sleeves) and show you, how it looks? If they were healthy, you are calling them bouncers? It is an insult. A healthy person can also be a Minister, no?" Sardesai queried.

Ujjain (Madhya Pradesh), March 1 (GNS): The management of Ujjain's Mahakal temple on Friday barred a priest from entering the temple premises after a video allegedly showing the priest molesting a minor girl went viral in social media. Ujjain Mahakal is one of the 12 famous "Jyotirlingas" of Lord Shiva across the country.

Although the police have not taken any action yet, they said that if a formal complaint is filed, "we'll surely take action".

However, priest Hemant Dubey has stated that it is a conspiracy hatched by older priests of the temple to frame him in the fake case.

In the wake of development, the Congress has questioned former Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chauhan as to which political powers are protecting criminals in the state. State Congress chief's media coordinator Narendra Saluja on Friday said in a statement that Hemant Dubey, who is allegedly involved in many

criminal activities, has connections with the Rashtriya Swamsevaka Sangh (RSS), Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad (ABVP) and the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP). Pulse Polio Program in City on March 10

Hyderabad, March 1 : In connection with the National Immunization day, pulse polio programme will be taken up in the city on March 10.

This was announced by Hyderabad District in-charge Collector G Ravi, at a review meeting here. He said that there are 4,85,965 children below the age of five years in the city, and instructions were issued to the health authorities to give pulse polio drops to all of them. The programme will be taken up from 7 am to 6 pm, he said and advised the parents to ensure that all the children were given polio drops without fail.

IAF pilot's parents get standing ovation in flight

New Delhi, March 1 (GNS) : The parents of Indian Air Force (IAF) Wing Commander Abhinandan Varthaman were given a standing ovation when they de-boarded an IndiGo Chennai-New Delhi flight here.

In videos uploaded on social media, the parents are seen alighting from the aircraft as passengers clapped and cheered them. According to people in the knowledge of the incident, although the parents wished to travel without any fanfare, fellow passengers discovered their identity and voluntarily gave them the first right of de-boarding. The 35-year-old Wing Commander was captured on February 27 by Pakistan after his MiG-21 Bison jet was shot down and crashed in Pakistani territory during a dogfight.

Water Tanker Hits Scooter ; girl student dies

Hyderabad, March 1 : A eight year old girl going to school died on the spot and her father was injured when a rashly driven water tanker hit their two-wheeler at Abids here this morning.

The mishap occurred when the girl identified as Dia Jain, a class three student of Rosary Convent High School, was on way to school with her father.

She was riding pillion and as their scooter was reaching the school, a private water tanker which was behind them rammed into the vehicle. Both of them fell on the road. While Dia died on the spot, her father Naresh Kumar Jain was injured.

IAF Pilot Abhinandan Varthaman, captured by Pak, Returns to India



New Delhi, March 1 (GNS) : Ending several hours of tense waiting, Wing Commander Abhinandan Varthaman finally returned to India to a rousing welcome at the Attari-Wagah joint check-post in Amritsar on Friday night. The Indian air force officer, who was expected to return much earlier, crossed into the Indian side after 9.15 pm. "Wing Commander Varthaman has just been handed over," said an Indian official. After the Pakistani officials handed him over, Indian officials took him over to the Indian side at the land check post.

He had earlier undergone a medical check-up at Wagah in preparation for the handing over.

The official formalities, including the signing of necessary documents and a medical examination by

the International Committee of Red Cross, were also completed, reports said. Hundreds of people had gathered at the border check post from early in the morning to welcome the 35-year-old Wing Commander, who was captured on Wednesday by Pakistan. The IAF officer was captured after his MiG-21 Bison fighter jet was hit by Pakistan Air Force jets on Wednesday near the Line of Control (LoC) in Jammu and Kashmir. On Friday morning, India's Acting High Commissioner Gaurav Ahluwalia arrived at the Pakistan Foreign Office in Islamabad for a briefing on the imminent release of Wing Commander Abhinandan. Wing Commander Abhinandan is to be accompanied back by India's air attache, who was headed to Lahore with

the IAF pilot's travel documents, Pakistani media reports said. The Pakistani authorities brought him from Rawalpindi to Lahore and handed over first to the International Committee of Red Cross (ICRC) under rules of the Geneva Convention before being brought to the JCP on Friday afternoon.

The Border Security Force (BSF), which mans the JCP and the 553-km long International Border with Pakistan in Punjab, was at high alert, with Punjab Police and other security agencies stationed and additional personnel since early Friday morning.

The border Retreat ceremony was also cancelled for the day in view of his return. Varthaman will be debriefed by defence and security officials after his return before he is taken

5 security men, one civilian killed in Kupwara operation against militants

Srinagar, March 1 (GNS) : Five security men were killed and four others injured in an ongoing gunfight on Friday in Jammu and Kashmir's Kupwara border district, defence sources said. One civilian also died during the operation.

The sources earlier said that two militants had been killed in the encounter after which searches were launched in Kralgund village.

"During the search operation after the firing exchanges stopped, one of the two militants, presumed dead, stood up and started indiscriminate firing at security forces in which two CRPF troopers, two Army soldiers and one local policemen were killed," police said.

"Four Army soldiers have been injured in the encounter and they have been shifted to a hospital," a police source said.

During clashes between security forces and civilian protesters near the gunfight site, four protesters were injured, out of which one succumbed later.

Police said bodies of the militants are yet to be recovered.

The gunfight occurred in Kralgund village of Langate area in Handwara tehsil of Kupwara district.

Rajnath inaugurates NIA office in city

(By Surendra Kumar)

Hyderabad, March 1 : Union Minister of Home Affairs, Shri Rajnath Singh said that the National Investigation Agency (NIA) has emerged as a premier agency in the country setting standards of excellence in counter terrorism and national security related investigations. Inaugurating the NIA office and residential complexes at Hyderabad and Guwahati, he said that there has been an increasing trend in the number of case being entrusted to NIA since its inception in 2009. Shri Rajnath Singh said that NIA has achieved conviction

rate of 92% in the cases assigned to it. Out of the total of 249 cases assigned charge sheets have been filed in 180 cases. The investigations carried out by NIA have resulted in significant decrease in number of youth joining terrorist outfits, he said. The Minister said that investigations conducted by NIA have helped unearth an entire range of illegal activities involving terrorist groups from terror conspiracy and funding to specific incidents of terrorism. The scope of NIA investigations encompasses terrorist outfits in India and also global terrorist orga-

nizations like JeM, Hizbul Mujahiddin, Lashkar-e-Taiba, etc.

Several complex cases such as twin blasts in Hyderabad in 2013, Patna Blasts (October, 2013), Pathankot terror attack case (January 2017) have been successfully investigated by NIA, Shri Rajnath Singh added.

NIA is assigned cases for investigation by the Ministry of Home Affairs either on the basis of a report from a state government on suo motu based on the gravity and complexity of the offence. It also acts as a nodal

to New Delhi from the Amritsar airport. On Thursday, Pakistan Prime Minister Imran Khan announced that the country will free Varthaman as a "peace gesture".

Tensions between the two countries escalated after Indian fighters bombed terror group Jaish-e-Mohammad's biggest training camp near Balakot inside Pakistan early Tuesday. It came 12 days after 40 CRPF personnel were killed when a Jaish-e-Mohammad suicide bomber rammed a vehicle carrying over 100 kg of explosives into their bus in Pulwama district of Jammu and Kashmir on February 14. Following Tuesday's cross-LoC airstrike by India, the Pakistan Air Force carried out retaliatory aerial strikes targeting Indian military installations. However, they failed to hit any target.

7% is no downward GDP growth for FY19: Garg

New Delhi, March 1 (GNS) : The government on Friday said there was no downward revision of GDP growth for 2018-19 (at 7 per cent) if seen in the context of growth rates for the last two financial years.

Subhash Chandra Garg, Secretary, Department of Economic Affairs (DEA), said on Friday the Second Advance Estimates of GDP factored in a higher base.

"The growth needs to be looked at in view of the higher base," Garg said.

On Thursday, the Central Statistics Office (CSO) lowered the FY19 GDP growth in the Second Advance Estimates of national income to 7 per cent from 7.2 per cent in the First Advance Estimates, attributing it to a slowdown in agriculture and manufacturing.

"The GDP was revised last year as well as the year before. This growth is on top of that. The real GDP has been revised upwards to Rs 144 lakh crore from the GDP in the first estimates for 2018-19, which was Rs 141 lakh crore. So the GDP has actually gone up from the earlier estimates," Garg said.

"Likewise, the nominal GDP has been revised upwards from Rs 188 lakh crore to Rs 190 lakh crore. So there is an upward revision in GDP as compared to the first estimates. Therefore, the 7 per cent growth has to be seen in the context of a much higher base due to the revisions which have been made.

"Last year's GDP was initially 6.7 per cent while this year's projection was 7.2 per cent. Now the previous year's GDP has been revised to 7.2 per cent while the projection for 2018-19 has been revised to 7 per cent. If these factors are taken together, the GDP has actually gone up from 6.9 per cent to about 7.1 per cent. There is no downward revision," the DEA Secretary said. India's economic growth slowed to a five-quarter low of 6.6 per cent in the October-December period of the present fiscal, according to the CSO statement released on Thursday. Slower growth in Q3, and the downward revisions in Q1 and Q2, has brought down the overall GDP projection for 2018-19 to 7 per cent from the earlier estimate of 7.2 per cent.

Election candidates must declare offshore assets now

Kolkata, March 1 (GNS) : Candidates in the upcoming Lok Sabha elections will have to declare their offshore moveable assets and liabilities in their affidavit, as per an amendment made by the Election Commission of India (ECI), an official said on Friday.

"To ensure that all moveable assets are reflected in the affidavit given by the candidates, a further category 'offshore assets' has been included for details of deposits of all assets and liabilities in foreign countries," Additional Chief Electoral Officer, West Bengal, Sanjay Basu told reporters.

He said Form 26 has been amended to ask candidates to submit a

statement of their income tax (I-T) returns for the last five years while they earlier had to file a statement of their (I-T) returns for just one year.

Alongside details of spouse and three dependents in the family, a new row has been inserted bearing the title Hindu Undivided Family for PAN details and status of I-T filing.

The office of the Chief Electoral Officer of the state will convene a meeting with all political parties regarding the changes, he said.

Chief Electoral Officer of Bengal, Aariz Aftab said as per the ECI guidelines this year all polling stations will have voter-verifiable paper audit trail (VVPAT) along with the

Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs).

The VVPAT will allow the voter to see whether the paper trail displays the same choice that he/she had pressed in the EVM.

Another major change is that both candidates and political parties can spend up to Rs 10,000 in cash. Any expenditure above this has to be made in electronic mode like RTGS or by cheque, draft, etc, he said.

"As far as donation is concerned, candidates cannot take more than Rs 10,000 in cash. Even in this case, anything above this amount has to be in electronic form," he said.

The ECI has launched a new GIS-enabled mobile application called 'cVIGIL', which creates a fast-track complaint reception and redressal system.

"Using this app any citizen can either take a photograph or make a two minute video if they see any violation of the Model Code of Conduct (MCC) or expenditure and upload it," he said.

Aftab said no content must be uploaded from phone memory, only live photo or video can be shared. A person can do it anonymously or share personal details and he/she will be updated about the status within 100 minutes, he added.

Although the police are yet to confirm it officially, sources said the arrested person was a constable who worked with the state armed police before going underground. "He is believed to be involved in the weapon loot that took place on December 31, 2018 when four rifles went missing from the guard's room of a Congress legislator in Jawahar Nagar area of Srinagar," sources said.

Now if you see a good, healthy Goan and you think he is a bouncer, it's your problem. We are a young political party and in this young party, there are many youngsters who work out," Sardesai said.

Photos of the bouncers guarding the office of the South Goa Planning and Development Authority (SGPDA) during a meeting on Thursday went viral in social media resulting in widespread criticism. Sardesai also said that using the "bouncer" slur was unfair and there was no question of intimidating anyone. "What is a bouncer? Don't I look like a bouncer? Should I roll up (his sleeves) and show you, how it looks? If they were healthy, you are calling them bouncers? It is an insult. A healthy person can also be a Minister, no?" Sardesai queried.

Ujjain's Mahakal temple bars priest after molestation video goes viral

Ujjain (Madhya Pradesh), March 1 (GNS) : The management of Ujjain's Mahakal temple on Friday barred a priest from entering the temple premises after a video allegedly showing the priest molesting a minor girl went viral in social media. Ujjain Mahakal is one of the 12 famous "Jyotirlingas" of Lord Shiva across the country.

Although the police have not taken any action yet, they said that if a formal complaint is filed, "we'll surely take action".

However, priest Hemant Dubey has stated that it is a conspiracy hatched by older priests of the temple to frame him in the fake case.

In the wake of development, the Congress has questioned former Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chauhan as to which political powers are protecting criminals in the state. State Congress chief's media coordinator Narendra Saluja on Friday said in a statement that Hemant Dubey, who is allegedly involved in many

criminal activities, has connections with the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS), Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad (ABVP) and the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP). "Chauhan should explain, who are the people whose names are surfacing during the two-month-old Congress regime. Who are the people trying to challenge the law and order and which political powers are protecting them? Waiting for your (Chauhan's) tweet," said Saluja.

Tell global community reasons for IAF strikes: Parliamentary panel

New Delhi, March 1 (GNS) : A parliamentary panel on Friday suggested that the government tell the global community more extensively and emphatically the reasons behind India's targeted attack on terror camps in Pakistan. The suggestion came here during a meeting of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on External Affairs which was briefed by Foreign Secretary Vijay Gokhale. Top officials of the External Affairs Ministry were also present. The meeting comes after India's attack on terror camps in the neighbouring country, followed by Pakistan's aerial incursion. According to sources, the members of the panel, headed by Congress leader Shashi Tharoor, suggested that the government tell the international community more extensively and emphatically that it was not an attack on Pakistan but a targeted attack on terror camps and terrorism.

Foreign Secretary Gokhale briefed the members of the parliamentary panel on the sequence of events from the air strikes on terror camps in Pakistan to how the Indian

forces foiled Pakistan's aerial incursion by shooting down one of their F-16 fighter jets in a dogfight which also led to the loss of one of India's MiG-21 Bison fighter jets, sources said. All members of the panel hailed the action of the Indian Air Force and called it a "heroic job". Sources added that Gokhale was also asked about the third-party intervention by the US and the UAE, to which he responded that he "could not speak for US President Donald Trump".

Trump had on Thursday said that the US had been "going at it" and had been involved in trying to have India and Pakistan de-escalate the matter. The US President had said that there is "some reasonably decent news" and hopefully it's coming to an end. Congress Presi-

dent Rahul Gandhi, who is also a member of the panel, was not present at the meeting. Sources said that the foreign secretary also informed the members about how India got the support of the members of the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) on the issue where External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj is a guest of honour. A member present in the meeting called the meeting "good and constructive" and said the purpose of the meeting was part of "parliamentary accountability". India and Pakistan engaged in aerial hostilities along the Line of Control (LoC) in Jammu and Kashmir for the first time since 1971 on Wednesday after the February 14 Pulwama terror attack that killed 40 Central Reserve Police Force troopers in Kashmir.

The action taken by Modi instills fear in the nations that plan to attack India and is also a warning bell to those countries that support terrorism, Panneerselvam said.

The ruling All India Anna Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam in Tamil Nadu has entered into an electoral pact with the Bharatiya Janata Party for the Lok Sabha polls.

OIC nations important partners in fight against terror, says official

Abu Dhabi, March 1 (GNS) : The OIC nations have expressed zero tolerance towards terrorism, T.S. Tirumurti, Secretary of Economic Relations at the Ministry of External Affairs, told the media on Friday.

He said it was a "historic day" in India's engagement with the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) as on the 50th anniversary of the first session of the OIC in 1969, India was invited as the guest of honour at the inaugural plenary of the 46th session of the Council of Foreign Ministers of OIC.

He said it opened a new chapter in India's engagement with the OIC.

"In her address, the External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj underlined that the fight against terrorism was not a confrontation against any religion. Her speech was widely welcomed," Tirumurti said.

"All the speakers in the session had no hesitation in saying that they had zero tolerance for terrorism," he added.

Responding to a media query on the Pakistan Foreign Minister saying that India had no moral right to be present at the OIC meet, the senior official said: "The invitation to India was extended in recognition of its global political stature as well as its time-honoured and deep-rooted cultural and historical legacy and its important Islamic component."

He pointed out that OIC nations catered to India's energy security and were home to the 12 million strong Indian diaspora. The volume of India's trade with OIC countries was \$230 billion, which was 30 per cent of our total trade. He said the OIC nations were India's "important partners" in fighting terrorism.

I am a pure RSS man, not in race for Prime Minister's post: Gadkari

New Delhi, March 1 (GNS) : Union Minister Nitin Gadkari on Friday said he was not in the race for the prime minister's post and as a pure RSS man for him the nation comes first.

"I have nothing to do with it (Prime Minister post). I am not in the race to be the Prime Minister. Prime Minister (Narendra) Modi is the Prime Minister and will be the Prime Minister even after the elections," he said speaking at the India Today Conclave.

The Water Resources Minister then said, "I am an RSS man and working for the country is our mission. Under Modiji, the country is progressing. So we all are behind him. I am just another worker in the fulfilment of his vision. Where does the question of me becoming a Prime Minister arise?" he

Modi attacks rivals over surgical strikes

Kanyakumari (Tamil Nadu), March 1 (GNS) : Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday made a no-holds-barred attack on some opposition parties, accusing them of questioning and doubting the armed forces and making statements that favour Pakistan.

"Some parties are converting their hate for Modi into hate against the nation. They are doubting the armed forces and are issuing statements favouring Pakistan. They are suspecting the fight against terrorism. These are the same people whose statements are being happily quoted in the Parliament of Pakistan and Radio Pakistan," he told a public meeting here after laying the foundation stone of a railway line between Rameshwaram and Dhanushkodi.

Modi did not take the name of any party in his attack at the meeting which was also attended among others by Tamil Nadu Chief Minister K. Palaniswamy, whose AIADMK has sealed a pact with the BJP for contesting the Lok Sabha polls.

The Prime Minister began his speech with the statement that every Indian was "proud that the brave" Wing Commander

Abhinandan Varthaman, taken captive by Pakistan, hailed from Tamil Nadu. He added: "I am proud that India's first woman Defence Minister is from Tamil Nadu."

Then Modi referred to the surgical strikes carried out by the Army after the Uri terror attack and the aerial attack on the Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM) training camp last month and quoted media reports to say that when the 26/11 terror attack happened in Mumbai, the armed forces sought permission to conduct surgical strikes on terror camps in Pakistan.

"But the UPA government blocked it. Today we are living in an era when the armed forces have full freedom. Terrorists and terrorism will be curtailed even more. This is the new India. The terrorists will be paid back with capital and interest."

"The armed forces are protecting the nation. I thank the armed forces. Well, the entire nation is proud of the armed forces as does the entire world. I salute all those who are serving the nation. It is their vigilance that keeps our nation secure," he said.

Attacking the opposition parties, Modi said: "I

want to ask them (parties) -- do you want to support our armed forces or raise doubts about them? Do they want to back our armed forces or support those forces which are helping foment terrorism on our soil?"

"Modi will come and go but India remains. Please don't weaken the country in trying to strengthen yourselves politically. Don't play with the defence and security of the country. We are Indians first. Your politics can wait," he said.

Modi then turned his attack on the Congress over corruption.

Referring to a late Prime Minister's talk of only 15 paise out of a Rupee going to the poor and an "arrogant" Minister claiming 'zero loss' in the spectrum case, he said: "Some talk of corruption as a way to life. It may be acceptable to them but not to me."

He said the NDA government had taken historic steps against corruption.

"The corrupt have to now give answers. The famous recounting Minister, who had insulted the middle class, now has to go to courts for bail for 'family pack' like the first family of the Congress

IAF officer killed in chopper crash cremated in Varanasi

Varanasi, March 1 (GNS) : The mortal remains of Indian Air Force flight engineer Vishal Pandey, who was one of the six persons killed in the Mi-17 transport chopper crash in Budgam district of Kashmir earlier this week, were consigned to flames at his native place in Varanasi, on Friday. In an emotionally surcharged atmosphere, the funeral pyre was lit by Pandey's younger brother Akash at the Harish Chandra ghat crematorium on the banks of the Ganga.

Hundreds of people from all walks of life, including teachers, policemen and IAF officials joined the last rites. The airman's body was brought by IAF personnel to his home late on Thursday amid heart-rending scenes. The 34-year-old was cremated with full state honours.

"And during my recent visit for 'Kumbh Snan' people told me that for the first time in 50 years they had found the river nirmal (clean)."

Highlighting the works of his ministry, he said that on the Yamuna river in Delhi he was working on 13 projects worth Rs 4,500 crore besides the work on the Ramnadi, Kali Ganga and 40 tributaries.

He also said that highway projects worth Rs 50,000 crore were underway.

"A bridge at Dhaula Kuan to decongest Delhi will be inaugurated on Saturday when I return from Nagpur and a foundation stone will be laid by the Prime Minister for Dwarka Express Highway soon," he said.

Gadkari also said that by March this year, the construction of highways is likely to reach 34 km per day against 28 km per day last year.

Modi, defence deals take centre stage at Rahul Gandhi's rallies

Mumbai/Dhule, March 1 (GNS) : Congress President Rahul Gandhi on Friday targeted Prime Minister Narendra Modi saying he has consistently refused to answer pointed questions on high profile defence deals in Parliament.

"Chowkidar chor hi nahi, darpok bhi hai (Chowkidar is not just a thief, but also a coward)," said Gandhi addressing a huge public rally in Mumbai's Bandra Kurla Complex.

Gandhi, who kicked off the Congress party's 2019 Lok Sabha campaign at two public rallies in Dhule and Mumbai, added that he was ready for any public debate on corruption, but the Prime Minister was scared and did not accept the challenge.

Termining the November 2016 demonetisation "a failed exercise", Gandhi said: "You stood in queues outside banks but not industrialists and businessmen like Nirav Modi, Mehul Choksi, Lalit Modi

The Congress' economic culture benefited only the ruling family and those close to them, he alleged.

"If there was anyone who spoke against the Congress economic culture, it was Rajaji who hailed from Tamil Nadu. We are implementing his policies and India is rising on the ease of doing business from the position of 77 five years ago to 142 now in the global index."

He said for the Congress social justice was just a slogan and during its regime there were innumerable atrocities against Dalits. He also accused the Congress of having defeated B.R. Ambedkar twice in elections.

Modi said the choice for the people in the 2019 elections was between two sides.

"On the one side strength and stability and the other stands weakness and vulnerability. Our leadership work culture is known across India; they are confused and have no leadership. They have no interest in the nation or people and are shamelessly indulging in corruption."

The Prime Minister also came down heavily on the DMK for politicking over portfolios after the 2004 elections which brought the UPA to power.

or Vijay Mallya, who converted their black money into white from the comforts of their plush homes. "On the recent border tensions, he said Modi always claimed that "India is united", but did not miss any opportunity to attack the Congress and the opposition, not even at the inauguration of the National War Museum. "After the CRPF troopers were martyred and a war-like situation came up, I instructed all Congressmen and appealed to the countrymen that nobody should criticise the government and India must stand united at this critical hour," he said. "We (the Opposition) decided that only after the national crisis gets over will we resume politics. However, the Prime Minister hasn't given up his PR even for five minutes," Gandhi thundered.

Addressing another rally in Dhule, Gandhi said that ever since Modi and the Bharatiya Janata Party

(BJP) took over in 2014, the Prime Minister had been making promises but did nothing to implement them. Attacking the government on issues of farmers and the youth, he said Modi had claimed that every 24 hours, 450 youth were being given jobs but China created 50,000 jobs every day, "and we have to overtake China and only the Congress can do this." He said Modi attempted to dilute the Land Acquisition Bill thrice but on all occasions the Congress, despite its small strength in Parliament, successfully stalled it. He pointed out that the government had given Rs 17 per family to the farmers but had written off loans worth Rs 3.50 lakh-crore of 15-25 big industrialists.

He said the Congress and the Nationalist Congress Party were fighting the 2019 Lok Sabha elections in alliance. "The people of Maharashtra will unite and teach a lesson to Modi and the BJP."

LS polls on time, says CEC Sunil Arora

Lucknow, March 1 (GNS) : Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) Sunil Arora on Friday said the ongoing tensions between India and Pakistan will have no bearing on the upcoming general elections in April-May this year.

Arora was responding to a query on whether the polls could be postponed in the wake of the situation post the February 14 Pulwama attack on a CRPF convoy in Jammu and Kashmir and the subsequent Indian Air Force (IAF) strike on terror camps across the border.

Talking to reporters at the Yojana Bhawan in the Uttar Pradesh capital, the top poll panel official said: "Elections will be held on time."

When asked about the possible notification of the Lok Sabha poll dates, Arora said the media and the country would come to know of it through the "usual press conference", as is the norm. In the state capital to assess the preparedness of Uttar Pradesh -- a state which sends 80 members to the Lok Sabha, Arora said that the poll panel is committed to holding a "free, fair, peaceful and transparent polls" and that all steps are being taken to ensure this.

"The Election Commission (EC) has a detailed action plan to address issues put to it," the CEC said while referring to the various suggestions, problems and issues shared with it during the meetings with state bureaucrats, police officials and representatives of political parties. He also trashed the often asked question on the fairness of the electronic voting machines (EVMs). "They are fool-proof, as has been proved many times in the past," he added.

Arora said that "unfortunately, EVMs have booms like footballs, where everyone is playing to his own".

EVMs, he added, had been used in

various elections, in which one or the other party won. "When the election outcome is not in favour of some, they start raising objections and questions," he said, adding that the poll panel has gone into the issue and found nothing wrong with the machines.

He also announced that Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT) will also be used in the 1,63,331 polling stations of the state during the Lok Sabha elections. A campaign to make people aware of this mechanism will also be rolled out in Uttar Pradesh and other states to ensure that they have complete understanding, the CEC said.

On being asked about the reaction of the political parties in the state to their reassurances about the credibility of EVMs, the CEC told IANS: "We have made ourselves clear to the best of our ability and hope the message is clear."

Arora also announced that an App called C-Vigil will be used extensively during the Lok Sabha polls across the nation. This App, which was used successfully in Bengaluru during the Karnataka Assembly polls last year, aims at providing a platform to the common man to file complaints and even know the action taken thereafter.

In the pilot, the poll panel had 28,000 complaints and in case the complainant wanted the identity to be kept secret, the action taken was published in the local media at a cost borne by the EC, the CEC added. The CEC also said that changes have been made in the Form 26 wherein the affidavits by candidates would have to include the husband, wife, children, dependants domestic and even foreign properties in their declaration. These would then be handed over to the Income Tax Department for verification.

For Congress, contesting Lok Sabha polls appears to be uphill task

For the Congress party leadership in BJP-ruled Himachal Pradesh, contesting the parliamentary polls appears to be an uphill task. A majority of Congress leaders apparently consider themselves over the hill, while all four incumbent BJP Members of Parliament are enthusiastic about going to the voters again. "There is too much confusion over who will lead the party in the Lok Sabha elections or who will contest," a senior state Congress leader, who did not wish to be identified.

He said the party is divided in two camps -- one led by six-time Chief Minister Virbhadr Singh and the other by former Union Minister Anand Sharma.

Octogenarian Virbhadr Singh has refused to contest the Lok Sabha elections from the Mandi seat he has thrice represented since 1971.

Former state ministers Mukesh Agnihotri and Asha Kumari and former state party president Sukhwinder Singh Sukhu are also reluctant to contest, party insiders say. The reason they cited is the party high command's decision not to field incumbent legislators. "The party cadre and the leaders are confused about who their leader is and who will take the party to victory," said a senior Congress leader, a cabinet minister in the previous Virbhadr Singh-led government.

Virbhadr Singh and his former MP wife Pratibha Singh, who are facing graft charges, are keen to launch their first-time legislator son Vikramaditya Singh from the Mandi seat. So is incumbent legislator Rajinder Rana, who is pleading the case of his greenhorn son from Hamirpur, a seat represented by three-time MP Anurag Thakur of the BJP. Rana has Virbhadr Singh's backing. "We are not in favour of fielding sitting legislators or kin of the leaders. We are going to take a final decision on candidates soon," Congress state in-charge Rajni Patil told reporters.

The BJP, led by Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur, seems confident of doing well in the polls.

"During the last five years, there has been unprecedented and unparallel development. The people of the country want Prime Minister Narendra Modi to once again lead the nation and thus, would definitely support him."

On getting a free hand to lead the party in the general elections, he said: "Each and every party worker of the BJP is our strength and responsible for victory of the party. Being head of the state, I would have greater responsibility to motivate rank and file to ensure victory of the party."

Ministry of Food Processing Industries issues guidelines for Operation Greens

Ministry of Food Processing Industry under the leadership of Union Minister Smt Harsimrat Kaur Badal is leading the food processing industry in India from the front. The efforts of the Ministry have led to a FDI in the food processing sector in India rising by 24 per cent in 2017-18. Highlights of the major achievements are as follows

Mega Food Parks: Ministry of Food Processing Industries is focusing on boosting the food processing industry so that agriculture sector grows exponentially and become a major contributor to doubling the farmer's income and aid 'Make in India' initiative of the government. To give a major boost to the food processing sector by adding value and reducing food wastage at each stage of the supply chain with particular focus on perishables, Ministry of Food Processing Industries is implementing Mega Food Park Scheme in the country. Mega Food Parks create modern infrastructure facilities for food processing along the value chain from farm to market with strong forward and backward linkages through a cluster based approach. Common facilities and enabling infrastructure is created at Central Processing Centre and facilities for primary processing and storage is created near the farm in the form of Primary Processing Centers (PPCs) and Collection Centers (CCs). Under the Scheme, Government of India provides financial assistance upto Rs. 50.00 Crore per Mega Food Park project.

Five Mega Food Parks were inaugurated during this period taking the total number of Mega Food Parks in the country to 14. These include

Paithan Mega Food Park in Aurangabad District in Maharashtra

Gujarat Agro Infrastructure Mega Food Park Himalayan Mega Food Park at Kashipur in Udhampur Singh Nagar district in Uttarakhand

Greentech Mega Food Park at Roopnagar Village in Ajmer, Rajasthan Satara Mega Food Park in Satara District, Maharashtra

Towards cleanliness Efforts towards cleanliness were undertaken under Swachhta Pakhwada which was observed from 16th to 31st October. On the first day the Minister launched the campaign with the inauguration of a book "Waste to Wealth Technology" prepared by Indian Institute of Food Processing Technology, Thanjavur, Tamilnadu. During the campaign industry bodies like ASSOCHAM, FICCI, DICCI, PHDCCI, AIFPA and CII organised Swachhta Awareness Programme and training camps for street vendors on food safety across New Delhi. The Minister conferred prizes to cleanest Mega Food Parks and Cold Chains.

Standing with Kerala in trying times

The Ministry made big efforts to reach out to the flood affected people of Kerala during the devastating floods. The Minister promptly called a meeting of industry representatives and sought a cohesive effort towards relief for the state. The Minister spoke with Chief Minister of Kerala and promised all assistance from the Ministry. Following the call from the Minister, food processing companies made generous contributions to relief efforts. Extension of time for completion was accorded to two Mega Food Parks under implementation in the state.

Advances in Food Processing Technology

International Conference on Recent Advances in Food Processing Technology (ICRAFPT) was organised at Indian Institute of Food Processing Technology, Thanjavur in Tamilnadu. The conference saw encouraging participation from speakers, both national and international, and provided a strong platform for knowledge sharing and meaningful discussion among the industry, academia, researchers and farmers which would potentially take the food sector growth to a newer heights. Over 09 overseas speakers, 77 Indian speakers, 18 food industry talks, 30 series lectures, 2 panel discussions, 8 student presentation, 605 poster presentation and 721 Abstract Publication took place in the conference which also saw release of new technologies and an expo of successful entrepreneurs groomed by IIFPT.

Collaboration with industry also got a fillip in the NIFTEM-Industry Forum organised at National Institute of Food Technology Entrepreneurship and Management in Sonapat in Haryana. The meeting aimed to identify challenges being faced by the Indian Food Industry, to bridge industrial and academic gap by industry oriented research projects, promote science & technology collaboration based on innovation by developing new technologies, new product development, refine exciting technological infrastructure which can be commercialized in future for the development of food processing sector. On the occasion, the Minister mooted the idea of a 'Brand NIFTEM' for processed food which would be healthier, fresher and cheaper. The Minister also highlighted that NIFTEM was a one of its kind institute and had the potential to become the Harvard of food processing technology and management sector.

Creation of facilities at NIFTEM:

The year saw NIFTEM expanding its infrastructure and adding an Incubation centre and Food Testing Laboratory to its repertoire. The laboratory would not only serve as a Centre for certification of food products but would also undertake research and innovation for solving the problems of

the food industry and the other stakeholders of the food sector. The Center would work in unison with the regulators and the policy makers for providing them all support for developing standard test protocols for various parameters of quality essential for domestic and international market and would serve as the National Reference facility in the years to come.

Modalities of Operation GREENS:

Operation Greens was announced in the Budget speech of 2018-19 with an outlay of Rs 500 crores to stabilize the supply of Tomato, Onion and Potato (TOP) crops and to ensure availability of TOP crops throughout the country round the year without any price volatility.

A major step was taken when the Ministry declared a two pronged strategy for operationalization of the scheme which comprises of Short term Price Stabilisation Measures consisting of a provision of 50% of the subsidy on Transportation of Tomato Onion Potato (TOP) Crops from production to storage;

Hiring of appropriate storage facilities for TOP Crops; and Long Term Integrated value chain development projects.

Capacity Building of FPOs & their consortium Quality production Post-harvest processing facilities Agri-Logistics Marketing / Consumption Points

Creation and Management of e-platform for demand and supply management of TOP Crops.

The Ministry declared that organisations eligible for the grant would include State Agriculture and other Marketing Federations, Farmer Producer Organizations (FPO), cooperatives, companies, Self-help groups, food processors, logistic operators, service providers, supply chain operators, retail and wholesale chains and central and state governments and their entities/organizations.

Better connectivity for grievance redressal:

The Ministry launched an in-house tollfree Interactive Voice Response service at 1-800-111175. People applying under various provisions of Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADANA Yojana can call on this number and get their queries resolved by the concerned department.

International Outreach MoFPI has made numerous forays even at the international level by way of participation in international events and hosting of international dignitaries and representatives of foreign companies at the Ministry; prominent among these being the inauguration of SIAL Paris by Union Minister in October. Bilateral meeting was also held with the French Agriculture minister for mutual cooperation. The Minister also met representatives from French company, Soufflet and CEO Cemafroid, international experts in cold

chain, refrigeration & air conditioning and discussed possibilities for collaborations and support in developing cold chain equipment testing laboratories in India.

Apart from this, representatives and delegations from various nations called on the Minister to discuss opportunities of investment and participation in food processing sector.

Budget Provisions:

Allocation for Ministry of Food Processing Industries was doubled in the Budget 2018-19 to Rs. 1400 Crores and Rs. 500 crore was allocated for 'Operation Greens' to address price volatility of perishable commodities like Tomato, Onion and Potato (TOP). The Ministry also initiated a proposal for the setting up of a Specialized Agro Processing Financial Institutions to unlock finance for establishing food processing industries. These institutions would help overcome the deterrents faced while installing food processing projects that are capital intensive and have long gestation period, by ensuring timely, accessible and affordable credit to this sector.

Skill Development

The Ministry launched a new sub-scheme i.e. Scheme for Human Resources and Institution - Skill Development (SHRISD) for assisting skilling infrastructure and Development of Course Curriculum with a budget outlay of Rs.27.50 Crore from 2017-18 to 2019-20 with following two components

1. Development of Course Curriculum / Training Module in English, Hindi and translation of the same in recognized regional languages based on the Qualification Packs (QPs) validated by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) as National Occupational Standards.

Grants-In-Aid is provided to the eligible Institutions upto a maximum of Rs.5.00 lakh per QP for development of training module both in print and multimedia for each job role and, up to a maximum of Rs. 0.50 lakh per QP is provided for the translation of already developed training modules in recognized regional languages as per 8th schedule.

2. Establishing Training Centre (TC) / Expansion of Existing Training Centre to impart skill/ training on various job roles in food processing as per the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF).

Grants-In-Aid is provided at the rate of 50% of cost of plant & machineries required for a National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF) validated training module subject to maximum of Rs. 15 lakh per training module and limited to maximum two training modules per Training centre (TC).

The Minister also launched Pradhan Mantri Koushal Kendra in Patiala where 1000 students will get free training in skill Development every year in the multiple courses.

In a bid to improve understanding of neurological disorders, researchers have created a fast and energy-efficient simulation of part of a rat brain by using computer chip manufacturer NVIDIA's Artificial Intelligence (AI) compute platform.

Developing faster and more efficient simulators could increase the level of understanding the brain function and identify how damage to a particular structure in neurons can lead to deficits in brain function. For creating the simulator, the researchers used computer hardware designed for 3D games, according to the study published in the journal *Frontiers in Neuroscience*. The study showed that a single Graphics Processing Unit (GPU) was able to achieve processing speeds up to 10 per cent faster than is currently possible using either a supercomputer or the SpiNNaker neuromorphic system, a custom-built machine.

The team was also able to achieve energy savings of 10 times compared to either the SpiNNaker or supercomputer simulations. The academics hope that the flexibility and power of GPUs means that they could play a key role in creating simulators capable of running models that begin to approach the complexity of the human brain.

"Our work shows that, in the near term, they (GPUs) are a competitive design for high performance computing and have the potential to make advances far beyond where CPUs have brought us to so far," said Thomas Nowotny Professor of Informatics at the University of Sussex in Britain. "We are very impressed by the use of the NVIDIA AI compute platform for brain simulations spear-headed at the University of Sussex and are glad we are able to support research at the leading edge of computational neuroscience as well as AI," Chris Emerson, Head of Higher-Education and Research Sales in UK and Ireland at NVIDIA, said in a statement.

Here's how gut bacteria can curb harmful effects of high BP

To a large extent our well-being depends on what bacterial guests in our digestive tract consume as researchers have found that beneficial gut microbes can produce from dietary fibre a fatty acid called propionate which can protect against the harmful consequences of high blood pressure.

The substance calms the immune cells that drive up blood pressure, according to the study published online in the journal *Circulation*.

"Propionate works against a range of impairments in cardiovascular function caused by high blood pressure," said lead researcher Dominik Muller, Professor at Max Delbrück Center for Molecular Medicine in the Helmholtz Association in Berlin, Germany. "This may be a promising treatment option, particularly for patients who have too little of this fatty acid," Muller said.

The results explain why a diet rich in fibre, which has been recommended by nutrition organisations for many years, helps prevent cardiovascular diseases. Whole-grain products and fruits, for example, contain cellulose and inulin fibers, from which gut bacteria produce the beneficial molecules like propionate. For the study, the researchers fed propionate to mice with elevated blood pressure. Afterwards, the animals had less pronounced damage to the heart or abnormal enlargement of the organ, making them less susceptible to cardiac arrhythmia. Vascular damage, such as atherosclerosis, also decreased in mice, the study said.

Low Vitamin D intake found in asthma patients

The recent research has found a reduced Vitamin D intake in occupational asthma patients.

Previously, Vitamin D intake was rarely evaluated in cases of occupational asthma regardless of it being an important part of nutrition. The main objective of this study was to assess the Vitamin D intake in occupational asthma patients and its relation with body mass index, co-morbidities related to Vitamin D deficit, lung function and quality of life.

The researchers found a reduced Vitamin D intake in both obese and non-obese asthma patients. The study was published in *JAMA Network Open*.

Lower intake was found in mild asthma group compared to severe asthma group. Regression analysis revealed a different pattern in the asthma groups.

The Impact score in irritant asthma indicated a stronger relationship with BMI while the symptom score in allergic asthma group was closely associated with the Vitamin D intake.

The researchers concluded that the relation between obesity and Vitamin D on clinical cores and lung function depended on the asthma phenotype.

It was recommended that the nutritional interventions in all occupational asthma phenotypes should be an important aspect in future treatments, especially targeting body fat reduction and achievement of daily recommended intake of Vitamin D.

The 21-year-old Japanese player took Twitter to confirm the hiring. "Had a great dinner with the team. Also taking this moment to thank Jermaine for joining us and coming on board lol," Osaka wrote.

Jermaine, who is a former All American collegiate star at Clemson University, served with Venus from 2015 until the end of last season. His brother Jarmere is currently Serena Williams' hitting partner. Earlier in January, Jermaine was named as a national coach for women's tennis by the USTA Player Development.

The reigning Australian Open champion's announcement comes two weeks after her decision to part ways with coach Sascha Bajin. "After this tournament I would want to start looking at people. It is not really ideal to go.

Ahead of World Cup, India look to continue experiments in Australia series

Hyderabad, March 1 : Getting the combination right for the World Cup will be the central theme when India take on Australia in a five-match ODI series starting here on Saturday.

India were white-washed 0-2 in the T20 series by the Aussies. But after the two games, skipper Virat Kohli said it won't impact much as the team is hellbent on experimenting with the XI to see which combination would work best in England and Wales this summer.

"Every team will look to fine-tune whatever they need to before the World Cup, and we'll keep doing that in the ODI series too, but we still want to win every match we play," skipper Kohli had said after the Bengaluru T20 loss.

In the Indian probable 15-member squad, there are two slots which are still to be claimed and the four contenders are K.L. Rahul, Rishabh Pant, Vijay Shankar and Siddarth Kaul. Dinesh Karthik, who has fallen out

of favour of late, will also believe he has an outside chance.

Since returning to the mix after his comments on a TV show led to his expulsion, Rahul has given a good account of himself in the two T20s with scores of 50 and 47.

All eyes will also be on Pant, who hasn't been consistent in the shorter formats but has the talent to take the game away from the opposition on his day. For Vijay Shankar, Hardik Pandya's fitness and his form could be an opening for him but the Tamil Nadu all-rounder needs to improve his bowling.

Kaul is a wild card and could get a look in with the management still trying with Khaleel Ahmed.

With Mohammed Shami and Jasprit Bumrah being automatic choices, Kaul will probably get two games to prove his worth.

Coming to the series, the Australians will be high on confidence after the T20 series win. But the 50-over format will be a different challenge altogether for

the visitors. India will welcome back Ambati Rayudu, veteran all-rounder Kedar Jadhav and Shami in the mix.

Also the formidable wrist spin pair of Kuldeep Yadav and Yuzvendra Chahal will be operating in tandem to add pressure.

The Aussies, buoyed by the maiden T20 triumph over India, will be eager to continue the momentum they have gained.

World Cup team will be more or less sorted out before IPL, says Virat Kohli

Hyderabad, March 1 : India captain Virat Kohli on Friday said the World Cup team will be decided before the Indian Premier League (IPL) starts and performances in the cash-rich domestic T20 tournament will have no bearing in team selection.

"No, I don't see the IPL having any influence on World Cup selection. I think that will be very, very radical sort of analysis," Kohli said on the eve of the first ODI against Australia.

"We need to have a solid team. Before we head into the IPL, we need to be absolutely clear of what team we want for the World Cup. I don't see anything changing on how the IPL goes for any of the players. If one or two players do not have a good IPL

season, it doesn't mean that they are out of the picture for the World Cup. Those things are not going to matter," Kohli set the record straight.

Young Rishabh Pant has been in poor form of late but Kohli said he will be given more opportunities but not at the cost of playing a bowler less.

"We will have to think about the combinations. I don't think playing a bowler less is a good idea because with the extra fielder in till the 40th over, it becomes very difficult to sort of get a few guys to chip in with a few overs here and there.

"We will have to work out the batting combination to try and give game-time to the guys we

want to. But, I don't see the bowling combination changing," the skipper said. Kohli also lavished praise on KL Rahul and hinted that he did impress the team management with his good shows in the T20s

"It augurs really well. KL, when he plays well, is operating at a different level I feel. We have seen him do that in the IPL last year and in patches over the last season we played as a team."

Kohli explained what makes Rahul special.

"It's very difficult to find a consistent player, who can play good cricketing shots and still win you games at a strike-rate of over 140 or 150. He has all the shots and has a solid game as well.

Elbow feeling good, says Smith on returning to nets

Sydney, March 1 : Steven Smith returned to the nets for the first time since his elbow injury in an attempt to be fit for the 50-over World Cup, starting May 30.

Australia right-handed batsman took Instagram to share a video of him having a hit. He can be seen donning a New South Wales shirt. "Great to have my first hit back today. The elbow is feeling good!" Smith captioned the post.

Smith and David Warner are both coming towards the end of their 12-month

suspension from the international cricket for the ball-tampering.

The duo are eligible to return to Australia colours on March 29, which is the day of Australia's fourth ODI against Pakistan in the UAE, but Smith is unlikely to be ready for that while Warner could be overlooked even if he returns to playing by then with the Indian Premier League (IPL) that starts March 23, ESPNcricinfo reported. "From all accounts they should both be ready for the IPL, which is

really positive. Dave's [David Warner] probably a little more advanced but my understanding is they will be ready to go in the not-too-distant future," Australia coach Justin Langer said.

Australia will head from India to the UAE to play five-match ODI series against Pakistan, the last international fixture ahead of the World Cup. The squad for the 50-over global tournament needs to be named by April 23, however, it can be changed later. Langer has spent time with both Smith and Warner, with

them training separately accompanying the New South Wales squad.

"I speak to them all the time. We are in touch all the time. [I have] been in touch with them for the last nine months and, as it gets closer to them coming back in the squad, I am not sure it increases - how much we speak to each other," Langer said. In their next assignment, Australia will face India for a five-match ODI series. The first game will take place at the Rajiv Gandhi International Stadium in Hyderabad on March 2.

Tim Paine rested from Sheffield game

Delhi, March 1 : Australia Test captain and wicket-keeper Tim Paine has been rested by Tasmania for their Sheffield Shield fixture against Victoria after pulling up a bit sore.

Paine sustained the injury during a match against South Australia in Adelaide, which Tasmania won by six wickets. However, coach Adam Griffith stressed the injury is not serious, though it comes after the wicketkeeper was struck down by illness following the six-Test home summer against India and Sri Lanka his maiden campaign on home soil as national captain, Cricket Australia reported.

"He is still getting over a really long summer, both mentally and physically. He just was not moving right in Adelaide, he was still a bit sore. It is more of a management thing it is not a major injury or anything. The prudent thing for us to do with a lot of players we have got four, maybe five shield games in a short space of time (after the Big Bash League break) we want to make sure we are playing our best cricket."

Ready to bat at four if team requires, says Kohli

Mumbai, March 1 : India skipper Virat Kohli on Friday said based on the requirement of the team, he will be "more than happy to bat at number four" in the World Cup, beginning May 30.

"I've batted a lot of times at number four. I don't necessarily try it out as I've done that a lot in the past. My game doesn't change much from number three to four because template is quite similar. In any given situation I try to play the game I know," Kohli said on the eve of ODI series against Australia.

When asked whether the Indian Premier League (IPL) will influence the World Cup selection, Kohli said he doesn't see anything changing with how the IPL goes for any player.

"I don't see IPL influencing the World Cup selection. That would be very radical analysis. We need to have a solid team before we head into IPL. We need to be clear as to what we want during the World Cup. If one or two

players don't have a good IPL season, it doesn't mean picture for World Cup will change," he pointed out.

Talking about the bowling options for the 50-over world tournament, India skipper said, "bowlers will depend on the opposition we will play, considering who will be more effective against the batsmen of other team".

He further said, "If conditions are seaming then it will be more pace dominating along with Hardik (Pandya) who is the all-rounder in the team. It is all about the combinations. I don't see one ahead of the other. Both (Yuzvendra Chahal and Kuldeep Yadav) of them together are the strongest spin bowling partners in the world at the moment. Our success in these couple of years is mainly because of these two guys and their impact in the middle overs and their ability to pick wickets for us."

When quipped if KL Rahul will make it to the World Cup squad, Kohli

said when Rahul plays he operates at different level, adding in patches over the last season he has performed brilliantly.

"He (Rahul) can keep batting like that. It's difficult to find a consistent batsman who can play good cricketing shots and still win you games. It's a rare ability and I think he's all the shorts. He can build on this and get some more innings under his belt. He's made strong case for himself in the World Cup," he said.

India will host Australia for a five-match ODI series to bring the curtain down on their international season ahead of the World Cup. The first game is scheduled on March 2 at the Rajiv Gandhi International Stadium in Hyderabad.

"Both the teams know each other very well. Australia has better idea of playing in Indian conditions because of their number of players playing in the IPL. So, we have to be our absolute best. Nothing can be taken lightly," Kohli said.

I-League clubs wait for meeting with AIFF chief

New Delhi, March 1 : League clubs are waiting for a meeting with All India Football Federation (AIFF) chief Praful Patel as their fate hangs in the balance.

With the I-League reaching its last lap for the 2018-19 season, the question once again doing the rounds is the much-talked about Indian Super League (ISL) and I-League merger.

This is a possibility that has been doing the rounds for the last few years. If some of the recent reports in the media are to be believed, this could be the last season for the I-League. This has created a kind of uncertainty among the clubs involved.

A letter submitted by the eight I-League clubs -- Aizawl FC, Chennai City, Churchill Brothers, Gokulam Kerala, reigning champions Minerva Punjab, Mohun Bagan, Neroca and East Bengal -- asking for a meeting with Patel to discuss their future has got no response. The clubs that did not sign the letter were Real Kashmir, Shillong Lajong (owned by AIFF vice-president Larsing Ming Sawyan) and AIFF's own team Indian Arrows.

A senior official of Minerva Punjab FC, a signatory to the letter, told IANS, "We have not received any confirmation about the meeting from the Federation." The Asian Football Confederation (AFC) constitu-

tion does not allow a member country to have two national leagues running simultaneously. This was made very clear by AFC General Secretary Dato' Windsor John when he was in Kolkata for the FIFA U-17 World Cup.

"It's not a question of what we are favouring. It's in the AFC constitution that one country should have one league.

We just gave provision (for two leagues) for a transition period. That's all," Windsor told reporters. "There will be one league for sure," he said.

While the AFC has already submitted a roadmap for the merger to the AIFF, the implementation of the roadmap is a huge task. All stake holders, including clubs of both the I-League and ISL, have to be on the same platform for the merger to become a possibility.

There is also the Football Sports Development Limited (FSDL) issue. The clubs in their letter have demanded that the country's top league should be run by AIFF and not their commercial marketing partners FSDL as they have a conflict of interest.

I-League CEO Sunando Dhar told IANS that the president is yet to confirm any date for the meeting. "We are yet to get a date for the meeting from AIFF president Praful Patel", he said.

ICC mulls all-time-on stump mics for World Cup

Sydney, March 1 : Broadcasters in Australia recently made a small experiment where they allowed no commentary in cricket matches but the stump mics were turned on all the time. The International Cricket Council (ICC), now, is mulling to replicate the same for the upcoming cricket World Cup. The tournament director Steve Elworthy said that he is in favour of keeping the stump mics turned on all the times and asserted that the idea needs to be discussed.

"From a fan engagement point of view, being able to do this for fans and spectators who are com-

ing to the game or are watching on TV, these things need to be discussed, and need to be addressed, ESPNcricinfo quoted Elworthy, as saying. People want to get close to their heroes. They want to understand what goes on in the heat of the battle. But you've also got to understand there are sensitivities around these things. So it is a fine balancing act," he said.

"But I would genuinely like to see that accessibility granted. I'd like to see it when players do get closer to the fans, [so] fans and spectators can witness what actually goes on the field, the director

added. Meanwhile, the Federation of International Cricketers' Associations (FICA) has called for a protocol to govern the use of the audio of the stump mic. FICA executive chairman Tony Irish voiced his concern saying that host broadcasters might make selective use of the audio.

ICC chief executive David Richardson said that from a disciplinary policing point of view they will ensure consistent use of the stump mic.

He further stated that stump mic is a useful medium to detect any offensive language or behaviour. What [ICC] will do, certainly from a disciplinary

policing point of view, we will make sure that we will apply [stump mics] consistently," Richardson told ESPNcricinfo. "So, although the broadcaster might decide not to broadcast to the public because he might feel that sometimes the comments on the field can be pretty banal and irritating, I suppose to the viewers, as long as that audio is still available to the match officials to use if necessary."

The audio from the stump mic will allow us to be more consistent in how that particular type of behaviour is policed. As to the players may be getting upset, that's silly.



Media should avoid hate news, says CEO Rajath Kumar

Hyderabad, March 1 : Chief Electoral Officer, Dr Rajath Kumar today suggested to the contesting political leaders to submit genuine details to the Election Commission and warned of criminal case and action if wrong information is filed. There was an increase of 20 per cent of paid news and a panel will be formed in districts to check the same, he said.

He suggested the media including print and electronic to stop propagating hate and intolerable speech. During a workshop on media role on elections, Rajat Kumar asked the media to avoid hate speech and news that will provoke

people on the basis of caste, community or religion.

The meeting gets importance ahead of Loko Sabha polls. The role of Journalists is key to the people and also for the political parties, and information should be objective in manner and not baseless speculations and rumours.

He said that steps will be taken to correct data that maligns the image of the candidates or a political party. Media has to focus on the opinion polls or elections with accurate data.

The CEO asked the candidates in fray to submit Form-26 with correct information and the EC is

vigilant of paid news. He said that 1,403 cases of paid news registered so far during the 2018 Assembly elections with 20 per cent rise. He observed that some publications favour some political parties and it can't be considered as paid news and specific news about candidates and similar promotion in multiple publications can be considered.

Rajat Kumar said that voters awareness programs will be conducted informing voters about the voting process and details. He also said the media should avoid airing any final, formal and definite results until EC declare them officially.

Education, health for all: Etala

Hyderabad, March 1 : Health Minister E Rajender today said that the government aims to provide the best health and education to the people. He visited NIMS here and inspected various wards on the occasion.

Comprehensive Master Plan for Hyd; CS holds meeting with officials

Hyderabad, March 1 : In tune with the Chief Minister's vision for bringing a transformative and innovative change of Hyderabad city, a high level preparatory meeting with all the line departments was held at the secretariat today. Presiding over the meeting Chief Secretary Dr S K Joshi asked the officials to submit the details along with the available data for preparing a concept note by the Administrative Staff College of India ASCI and MAUD (Municipal Administration and Urban Development) department by this Tuesday. The concept note is part of the comprehensive master plan which will be prepared by the ASCI within six months.

Officials who spoke on the proposed master plan observed that plan should include within ORR, between the ORR and RRR and outside five kms of RRR. It should also include zoning of areas for development of economic anchors such as media hub, sports hub, health care hub among others. Integrated satellite townships for all inclusive development should also be part of the master plan. Balancing growth with development, review of institutional structures, governance for improved performance and accountability and development of infrastructure with an eye on the next 30 years should be incorporated in the plan, chief secretary said.

Principal Secretary Municipal Administration Arvind Kumar said that the plan would look into the transportation, traffic congestion, ease of living aspect, drinking water and road plan as well. Strengthening institutions and innovative financing to support city development will also be part of the master plan, he added. Venkaiah Naidu has said that the education we impart in our schools, colleges and universities must lead to self discovery, enlightenment and awakening of an individual. He was addressing the gathering at the Platinum Jubilee Celebrations of Andhra Vidyalaya College of Arts, Science & Commerce, in Hyderabad today. The Minister for Education, Telangana, G. Jagdish Reddy and other dignitaries were present on the occasion.

The Vice President said that by 2020, the median age in India will be just 28, compared to 37 in China and the US, 45 in Western Europe, and 49 in Japan. Demographics is a game changer in economic development and can transform the pace and pattern of economic growth, he added.

Naidu said that investing in people through healthcare, quality educa-



tion, jobs and skills helps build human capital. He further said that though India has made considerable gains in human development, it still grapples from challenges of illiteracy, big barriers to secondary schooling, low-quality public services, and gender discrimination. It is time for India to pursue a much more aggressive education plan, exploiting the new tech-

nology opportunities, he added. The Vice President said that there should be renewed focus on gender equality and safety of women through gender sensitization and gender sensitization must begin at the home, schools and colleges.

He urged the institution to do everything in its power to encourage more and more young women to avail opportunities of higher education. Saying

that even when jobs are available, candidates with the right skill set that fit the job are not available, the Vice President suggested to tackle this issue with the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna 2.0 which has been launched in October 2016 and aims to train 10 Million Youth over a period of 4 years.

Advising to pay attention to equity in access to education, the Vice Presi-

dent said that women and girls, Scheduled Castes and Tribes, differently-abled and minority groups need to have a barrier free and equitable access to higher education.

LB Nagar flyover Opens for public; Rs 42 Cr spent

Deputy mayor Baba Fasiyuddin, MLA Sudhir Reddy, and GHMC Commissioner Dana Kishore and others attended the program.

The flyover was built at a cost of Rs 42 crore and the launch was delayed by a month. Speaking on the occasion,

Mahamood Ali said that the flyover in LB Nagar will address the long awaited traffic problems. The government is spending huge funds for providing better public transport system through roads, infrastructure and facilities.

Like no other city, Hyderabad is being developed as a global city. Chief Minister K Chandrasekhar Rao is keen on better connectivity to the people in the city and in districts, he claimed. Also to reduce traffic problems, the under pass will be operational, he said. The people can use the flyover to reach Vijayawada or other areas from this

cross roads. The city provides people ample space to make a better living, he said. The flyover will reduce traffic problems towards Hayatnagar, Choutuppall and Vijayawada and other areas.

GST Feb collection up 13%

New Delhi, March 1 (GNS) : The revenue collection under the Goods and Services Tax (GST) rose more than 13 per cent to Rs 97,247 crore in February as against Rs 85,962 crore in the year-ago month, the Finance Ministry said on Friday.

"The total gross GST revenue collected in the month of February, 2019 is Rs 97,247 crore," the Ministry said in a statement. In January 2019, it stood at Rs 1,02,503 crore, becoming the third month in the fiscal crossing the Rs 1 lakh crore mark.

Out of the Rs 97,247 crore collected in February 2019, Rs 17,626 crore was collected as Central-GST (CGST), Rs 24,192 crore as State-GST (SGST), Rs 46,953 crore

as Integrated-GST (IGST) and Rs 8,476 crore as cess.

The IGST amount includes Rs 21,384 crore collected on imports and the cess includes Rs 910 crore collected on imports, the statement said.

The revenue in February, 2018 was Rs 85,962 crore and the revenue during February, 2019 grew by 13.12 per cent over the revenue in the same month last year, it said.

The total number of GSTR 3B Returns filed for the month of January up to February 28, 2019 is 73.48 lakh, the government said. Further, the government has settled Rs 19,470 crore to CGST and Rs 15,747 crore to SGST from IGST as regular settlement.
