MANUU's distance Follow-on Courses Registration& Re-Registration

Hyderabad:

The Directorate of Distance Education, Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) has revised the schedule of registration for follow-on-courses of distance mode Under Graduate (2nd and 3rd year) and Post Graduate (2nd year) courses including re-registration.

For students appearing in backlog papers, the re-registration fee is Rs. 1,000/- in addition to Rs. 400/- per paper for PG and Rs. 300/- per page for UG.

Meanwhile, extended last date of submission of online applications for admission into various distance courses without late fee will end tomorrow on August 21.
