  7. Migration certificate(from the institution last attended)
  8. Valid caste / category certificate (format prescribed by Government of India) if applicable
  9. Bonafide / Conduct certificate (from the institution last attended)
  10. Four passport size latest colour photographs of Candidate
  11. One Photograph each of Parents / Guardian

Requisite Admission fee (at Hyderabad Campus: Boys- Rs. 5200/, Girls- Rs. 1150/- at other campuses: Boys- 5000/-, Girls-950/- and Health Insurance fee of about Rs. 1000 for Hyderabad Campus only (when the University notify it) to be submitted through Credit Card / Debit Card / Net Banking after provisional seat allotment. Please ensure to carry your Credit Card / Debit Card / Net Banking Account with sufficient funds.

- ◆ Candidates from the provisional rank list notified by the University for M.Ed program may attend the registration for counselling on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2018 between 9.00 am to 11.30 am. Counselling for Admission shall start at 11.30 am based on the merit of the available candidates following the reservation. On non-availability of reserved candidates (except SC and ST categories), the seats will be filled-up with general category candidates following the merit among the reported candidates.
- ◆ Those candidates who have taken admission in the 1<sup>st</sup> phase counselling will not be permitted to attend 2<sup>nd</sup> phase counselling.
- ◆ Those candidates who attended the 1<sup>st</sup> phase counselling and not secured a seat may also attend.
- ◆ All the candidates who have not attended in the 1<sup>st</sup> phase counselling may be considered if there is availability of seats based on their reservation category.
