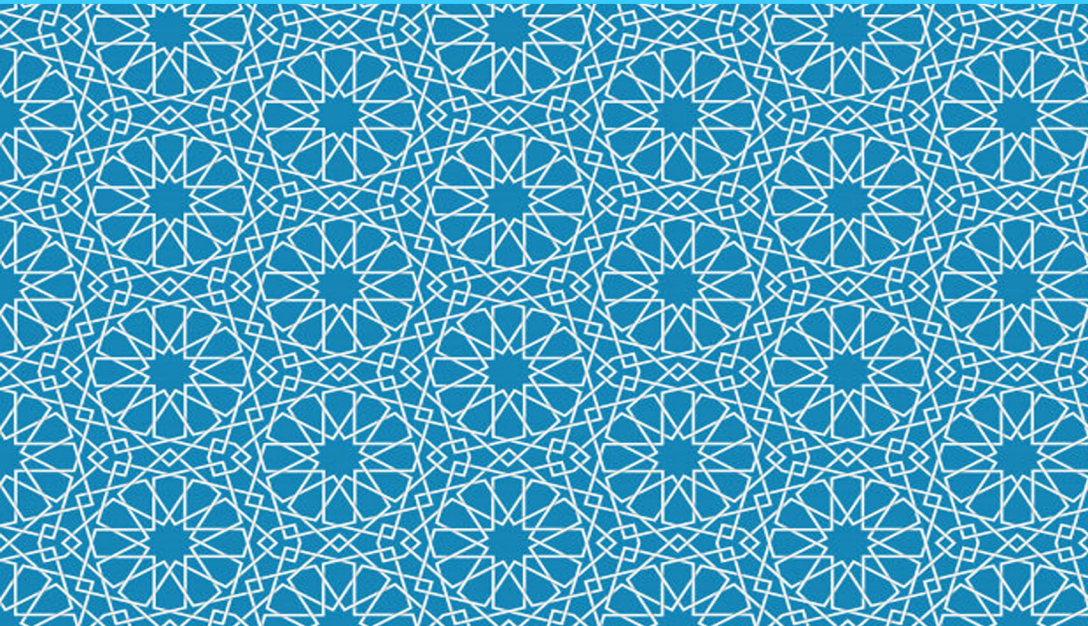




The Infrastructure Facilities

The Department is located on the 1st floor of the Instructional Media Centre. This gives advantage to our students for their practical inputs for TV and Radio Productions. The Instructional Media Centre has a state-of-the-art instructional audio studio and video studio, MTV studio on multi-cam online setup with all associated facilities, and has several units of outdoor shooting.

The students have facilities to learn and get trained in print media to lay down design on Quark Express, Coral Draw, Adobe photoshop, In-page etc related to prepare the content and its design in the first semester through its practical paper i.e. Print Journalism Practical's. The Print Lab is fully equipped with 14 high end computers to publish in-house Lab Journal/ Wall Papers by the students.



Video STUDIO

The infrastructure of IMC consists of a Video Studio, Audio Studio, associated control rooms, and a comprehensive post production facility by way of audio edit suits and three Video edit Suits. The Video studio has a state of the art multi camera online setup which is equipped with high-end broadcast grade cameras (Sony make D-55PH) and adjoining PCR has 32 channel audio mixer and associated production gear. Lighting in the video studio is provided by a flexible, motorized lighting grid containing cool lights. Comprehensive training is provided on single camera, multi camera techniques and the use of teleprompter for news reading.





Outdoor Equipment

The Department has HDTV compatible cameras (1- HVR-ZIP (4K), 1- PD170 and 2- SONY Handy-cams,) which are provided to students for outdoor/ENG shooting. The Department has acquired one sennheiser wireless microphone for outdoor recording. Students regularly use Two (02) professional DSLR, D-75 Still Camera for practical exercises.





Audio Studio & Graphic Lab

The Audio studio with its associated control room is equipped for digital audio recording on Audio work station. The Department has one 'Sony-Fex Courier' for outdoor recording and Sound Forge soft-ware for different types of Radio Productions.

The Department of MCJ has fifteen (15) high end 'Graphic Workstations' with sophisticated soft-wares like AutoDesk Maya animation soft-ware and other computer graphics and animation software's at Graphic & Animation Lab.





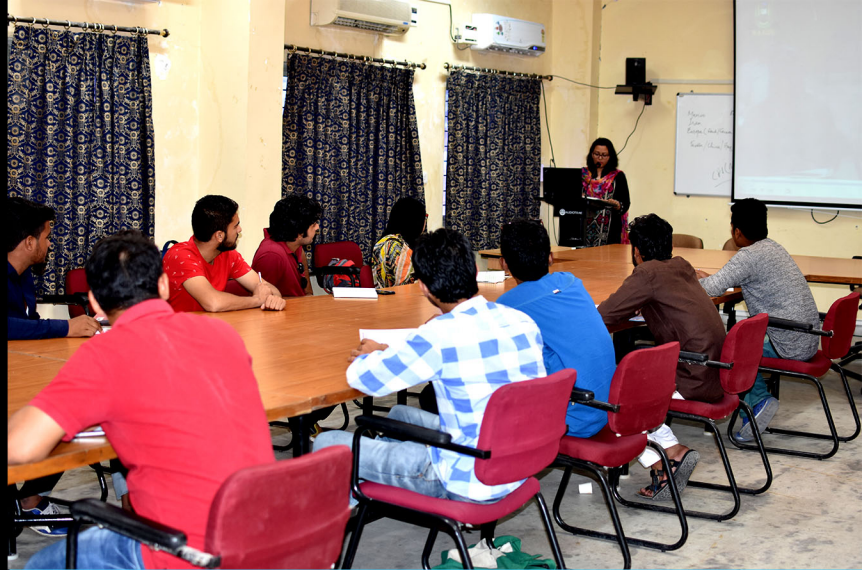
The Department has recently procured eight (08) I-MAC systems with Final Cut Pro (FCP) software for post production work related to ENG/EFP productions.
