Profile of the University:

Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) is a central university established in the year 1998 by an Act of Indian Parliament, with all India Jurisdiction, to promote and develop Urdu language, impart vocational and technical education in Urdu medium through conventional and distance modes and focus on women education. The headquarter of the University is at a central location of Gachibowli in Hyderabad and spread over 200 acres. The university has been awarded 'A Grade' by NAAC in 2009 and again in 2016.

Over the last nineteen years, MANUU is working as a mission-driven University with a strong commitment to teaching, learning, research and innovation along with a special focus on women education to fulfill its statutory mandate.

The University has a unique distinction of offering courses and programmes from elementary to higher education in general and professional, technical and vocational streams in particular in Urdu. It is catering to the educational needs of the large sections of unreached Urdu population of the society and delivering education through teaching, research, training and outreach activities with well established Schools, Departments, Centres and Satellite campuses. At present there are 7 Schools; 24 Departments; 11 Centres; 10 Colleges; 3 Polytechnics; 3 Industrial Training Institutes; 3 Model Schools and a CSE Coaching Academy. The university is offering 17 Ph.D, 12 M. Phil, 25 Post Graduate and 18 Under Graduate programs and a few Diploma and Certificate Courses. The University has approximately 400 regular faculty, 400 non-teaching staff and 6000 regular students from across India. Most of the Schools of Studies have already produced a considerable number of U.G and P.G Degree holders and M. Phil and Ph.D Scholars. Further, the university has a Directorate of Distance Education at Headquarters with 9 Regional Centres (RCs), 4 Sub-Regional Centres and about 175 Study Centres across the country and offering several programmes in Urdu at the door steps of the learners. Moreover, the University has a satisfactory record of its well placed Alumni. Furthermore, the diversity of University Campus is also good with proportionate male-female ratio and representation of different sections of the society.

About Organizers

The first National Urdu Social Science Congress, 2017 is scheduled to be organized by the Centre for Promotion of Knowledge in Urdu (CPKU) in association with School of Arts & Social Sciences. The School of Arts and Social Sciences (SA&SS) was established in the year 2006. The School currently consists of eight Departments i.e., Women Education, Public Administration, Social Work, Political Science, Islamic Studies, History, Sociology and Economics and is actively engaged in teaching and research. In 2016, the university has established the Centre for Promotion of Knowledge in Urdu to develop knowledge of different disciplines in Urdu. The Centre also aims to hold at least two National Urdu Congresses and publish two peer reviewed journals in Science and Social Science respectively every year.

First National Urdu Social Science Congress 2017:

Urdu language has a rich depository of knowledge in the fields of literature and religion, compared to its contribution to the fields of Sciences and Social Sciences. Hundred years back, the experiment of Osmania University to teach Sciences and Social Sciences in Urdu medium was a great success. Later, Urdu as a medium of instruction has been replaced with English and other vernacular languages not only in Osmania University but also in most of the other institutions. However, Urdu is still a medium of instruction in a good number of schools, colleges and madaras across India. Nevertheless, the declining social acceptability of Urdu as a language in higher education is a matter of great concern. Equally, there is a need to address the growing paucity of knowledge in Urdu in the field of Social Sciences and other fields of knowledge.

Under the above circumstances, the establishment of MANUU by Indian Parliament has undoubtedly rekindled the hope of reviving Urdu through teaching, learning and research in Social Sciences and other disciplines. To pursue its mandate, the University has successfully organized the Urdu Science Congress in February, 2017. Further, in pursuit of it, the Centre for Promotion of Knowledge in Urdu (CPKU) in association with the School of Arts & Social Sciences (SA&SS) of the University is going to organise the first National Urdu Social Science Congress on 14th and 15th December, 2017. The purpose of this Congress is to bring together the Urdu knowing scholars, teachers, research scholars and all other stakeholders of Social Sciences on one platform. It aims to address the challenges of teaching and research in Social Sciences in Urdu and explore the ways and means for the development of Urdu as an effective medium for the growth of Social Sciences to understand the changing social phenomenon.

Guidelines for Paper Submission:

Participants are requested to contribute original and well researched papers on the main theme and sub-themes in Urdu for the Congress. Abstracts of the paper should not be in more than 300 words. The abstracts must focus on the uniqueness of the topic and the theoretical, empirical or analytical grounding of the research paper. It should also include the title, name of author(s), keywords, university/institution of affiliation and detailed address. Full length paper should not exceed 5000 words typed in Urdu In-page.

Call for details of Urdu Writers in Social Sciences

The university intends to release Directory of Urdu writers in Social Sciences titled "Safeeran-e-Samaji Uloom" in the Congress. As such all the Urdu writers in Social Sciences are requested to e-mail the details of their contribution to Social Sciences in Urdu in the prescribed proforma to the convener of the Congress at the earliest.

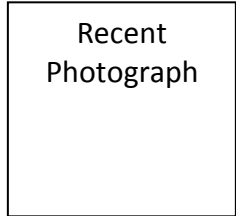
