Jaipur, Aug 19 (GNS) : Former Prime Minister Manmohan Singh was elected unopposed to the Rajya Sabha from Rajasthan on Monday.

Since the Bharatiya Janata Party did not put up any candidate due to lack of numbers in the assembly, Manmohan Singh was declared elected after the scheduled time to withdraw nominations ended on Monday.

Chief whip Mahesh Joshi accepted the certificate of election on behalf of the former Prime Minister. The seat had fallen vacant due to the death of sitting member, BJP state chief Madan Lal Saini. Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot and Assembly Speaker C.R. ## India is ageing and Age-Related Macular Degeneration (AMD) is on the rise

Hyderabad, Aug 19 : According to the UN, the share of the elderly population of 60 years and above, is projected to increase to nearly 20 per cent by 2050 in India. In a report published by the United Nations Population Fund (UNPFA) recently, six per cent of India's population was of the age 65 and above. Along with the rise in the ageing population, there is increase in the number of people affected by degenerative diseases. Degenerative as the name suggests is a process of deterioration of the cells over a period; Parkinson, Osteoarthritis, Age-related Macular Degeneration (AMD) are a few examples of degeneration diseases. While eye diseases like cataract and glaucoma are commonly known, diseases related to the retina (back of the eye) are least known to public.

AMD is one of the important causes of severe visual loss in the elderly population. AMD constitutes 8.7% of blindness in the world and the blind population in India is about to rise to 15 million by 2020. AMD affects the central vision which is essential for detailed tasks requiring fine vision, such as reading and recognizing faces. Common symptoms include blurred or fuzzy vision, straight lines that appear wavy or crooked, decreased contrast or colour sensitivity, difficulty in seeing from a distance, a small but growing blind spot in the center of vision. AMD is an irreversible by manageable disease provided the disease is diagnosed early. Anti-VEGF (Vascular Endothelial Growth Factor) therapy can help slow or halt the disease progression in some cases.

Lack of awareness about the condition and its symptoms leads to delayed detection which causes vision loss. To avoid this, it is critical for patients and their caregivers to be aware and alert in recognizing the disease. Most patients and their families confuse AMD with old-age or poor vision, sometimes it is confused with cataract. Dr Raja Narayanan, Hon.

## NIRDPR study on Solid Waste

### Management units in Gram Panchayats

(By SP Bureau) Hyderabad, Aug 19 : National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj (NIRDPR) conducted a series of case studies across States in India in order to devise practicable models of solid waste management (SWM) for Gram Panchayats (GPs).

Under the Swachh Bharat Mission in India, several States are ramping up implementation to be able to announce an 'Open Defecation Free' (ODF) status by 2nd October 2019. The next big challenge facing the Gram Panchayats under Swachh Bharat Mission-Gramin is establishing systems for management of solid waste and wastewater.

Society generates waste day-in and day-out, but at the end of the day, they all fall in the lap of Gram Panchayats or Municipalities to clean up. Certainly, sanitation is one of the key duties of local bodies. However, the indiscriminate disposal of waste pollutes land, con-



taminates water, and renders villages and towns unsightly and unlivable. This is increasingly becoming a major problem as the waste generated is not segregated at the source while collection and is of the order of 0.3 to 0.4 million metric tonnes per day (rural), as estimated by the Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation.

The study carried out by NIRDPR provides a comprehensive guide and several models for Panchayats to prepare, organize, implement and monitor Solid Waste Management (SWM) systems in rural areas. States such as Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh,

Karnataka and West Bengal, along with a few Gram Panchayats in Gujarat and Chhattisgarh have a few SWM units that are being managed admirably well. Rural local bodies can learn and adopt some best practices, which are presented in the step-by-step Guide prepared by NIRDPR as an outcome of this research.

Dr. P SivaRam, Head, and Dr. R Ramesh, Associate Professor, Centre for Rural Infrastructure (CRI), NIRDPR, studied the practices and interviewed the people behind the success in these GPs and documented the best practices.

enough to withstand external economic shocks. The Indian economy is in grip of a severe slowdown, while the domestic automobile sector is facing its worst crisis in 20 years.

TSociety of Indian Automobile Manufacturers (SIAM) reports that 300 dealerships have shut down in recent times. Sales of cars, tractors, two-wheelers have declined considerably. SIAM said about 10 lakh jobs have been hit in the auto component manufacturing industry.

The health of real estate, which is a massive indicator of the state of the Indian economy and has links with about 250 ancillary industries like bricks, cement, steel, furniture, electrical, paints, among others, is causing major concern. Due to demand slowdown both the sectors have seen huge build-up of inventories. The fast-moving consumer goods (FMCG) companies have reported decline in volume growth in the April-June quarter. While the labour force survey, released by the government in July, showed a record high unemployment rate of 6.1 per cent for 2017-18, a recent RBI report does not present a bright picture. The RBI consumer confidence survey showed a drop in consumer confidence in July on account of a pessimist outlook on job creation and on the overall economic scenario. Amidst all the gloom, foreign portfolio investors (FPIs) continue to pull out from the equity market on account of a tax surcharge levied in the latest Budget.

The ED is investigating purported irregularities of the IL&FS' loan and investments worth over Rs 850 crore in the Joshiv-owned Kohinoor CTNL, a realty firm, which is building the Kohinoor Squares Tower in Dadar west.

Joshi Junior's company and its investments have been under the scanner for having defaulted on an estimated Rs 135 crore of IL&FS.

Launched over a decade ago by Umesh Joshi, Thackeray and another business associate, Kohinoor CTNL was planning to buy the defunct Kohinoor Mills No. 3 for Rs 421 crore, in which the IL&FS had pumped in Rs 225 crore.

Suddenly, in 2008, the IL&FS reportedly backed out of the deal and sur-

rendered its shares for only Rs 90 crore, suffering a huge loss. Subsequently, Thackeray too exited after selling his shares. Later, the IL&FS extended loans to Kohinoor CTNL on which it defaulted.

In 2017, the company entered an agreement to sell some commercial and residential properties in the upcoming Kohinoor Square Towers to IL&FS to settle an outstanding of around Rs 500 crore in loans. Following this, IL&FS extended another Rs 100 crore to Kohinoor CTNL on which it defaulted.

Incidentally, Joshi's Kohinoor Group -- founded by his father Manohar Joshi -- which earlier controlled the Kohinoor CTNL, is now
