WALK-IN INTERVIEW

**FOR ASSISTANT PROFESSOR AT SCHOOL OF EDUCATION & TRAINING,
DIRECTORATE OF DISTANCE EDUCATION AT HYDERABAD AND
COLLEGES OF TEACHER EDUCATION (CTEs) LOCATED IN DIFFERENT STATES**

The University desires to engage the services of Assistant Professors on short term contractual basis to teach B.Ed/M.Ed. programmes under School of Education & Training, Directorate of Distance Education at its Gachibowli Main Campus in Hyderabad and Colleges of Teacher Education (CTEs) located at different States of the Country in the following discipline for the academic year 2019-20:

Subject / Discipline

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Essential qualifications:

- A. (i) Postgraduate degree with minimum 55% marks in the discipline relevant to the area of specialization.
- (ii) Postgraduate degree in Education (M.Ed/M.A. Education) with minimum 55% marks.
- (iii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D.Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.
- (iv) Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions :-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

(* Qualification for the discipline related to Health & Physical Education:

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Physical Education (M.P.Ed/M.P.E., recognized by NCTE) with minimum of 55% marks.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or CSIR.
- (iii) Provided that, candidates registered for the Ph.D. degree prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/ Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. degree holders shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges / Institutions, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-
 - a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in regular mode;
 - b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
 - c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
 - d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
 - e) The candidate has presented at least two research papers in conference/ seminar, based on his/her Ph.D work.

Note: The fulfillment of these conditions (a) to (e) is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

- (iv) Passed the physical fitness test conducted in accordance with the UGC Regulations 2018.

Physical Fitness Test Norms:

- (a) Subject to the provisions of these Regulations, all candidates who are required to undertake the physical fitness test are required to produce a medical certificate certifying that he/she is medically fit before undertaking such tests.
- (b) On the production of such certificate mentioned in sub-clause (a) above, the candidate would be required to undertake the physical fitness test in accordance with the following norms:

(#) Qualification for the discipline related to Fine Arts & Performing Arts:

Eligibility (A or B):

- A. i) Master's Degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/foreign University.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be.

Provided further, candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws / Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges /Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- a) Ph.D. degree has been awarded to the candidate in a regular mode
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
- d) candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which, at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two research papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars supported/funded/sponsored by the UGC/AICTE/ICSSR or any other similar agency.

Note 1: The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affair) of the University concerned.

Note 2: The clearance of NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC (like SLET/SET).

OR

B. A traditional or a professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the subject concerned having a Bachelor's degree, who has:

- i) studied under a noted/reputed traditional Master(s)/Artist(s)
- ii) Has been 'A' grade artist of AIR/Doordarshan;
- iii) Has the ability to explain, with logical reasoning the subject concerned; and
- iv) Has adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in the discipline concerned.

For Drama Discipline (Performing Arts):

Eligibility (A or B)

- A. i) Master's Degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/foreign University.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, or 2016, and their amendments from time to time as the case may be.

Provided further, candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme, prior to July 11,2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in the regular mode; b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners; c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted; d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal; e) The candidate has presented at least two research papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars supported/funded/ sponsored by the UGC/CSIR/ICSSR or any other similar agency.

Note: 1. The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: 2. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which the NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

- B. A traditional or a professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who has:
- been a professional artist with three years' Bachelor degree/Post Graduate Diploma, with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed), from the National School of Drama, or any other such Institution in India or abroad;
 - five years of regular acclaimed performance at regional/ national/ international stage, supported by evidence; and
 - the ability to explain, with logical reasoning, the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in the discipline concerned.
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2. **Monthly Remuneration:** Salary not exceeding ₹50,000/- per month as per UGC norms. Engagement of contractual faculty shall be on full time basis except Physical Education, Fine Arts & Performing Arts/Drama discipline.

3. **Additional Urdu Qualification for all teaching positions:**

The medium of instructions in MANUU is Urdu. Therefore, candidate should possess a valid Urdu qualification at appropriate level and should be able to teach through Urdu and evaluate assignments/papers.

4. **Age limit:** Preferably below 35 years.

5. **Engagement of serving or retired University/College teachers:**

Retired teaches (Professors/Associate Professors/Assistant Professors) from Government recognized Institutions below 65 years are also eligible for any of the above discipline. Similarly serving teachers in other institutions can be considered for part time per lecture basis for - *Physical Education, Fine Arts & Performing Arts/Drama discipline.*

6. Candidates fulfilling the above qualifications may walk-in for interview on **21st June, 2019 at 9.00 a.m.** with their resumes, original educational, experience certificates, proof of knowledge of Urdu, testimonials and passport size photograph along with one set of attested photocopies thereof for verification. The interviews will be held at University Guest House, Urdu University Road, Gachibowli, Hyderabad on their own expenses. The candidates must report at 8.30 a.m.
